# Dear Neighbor,

You likely caught wind of the issues that held up this year's state budget process, either from local news or my social media/email updates. But the state budget is now officially implemented - for the most part.

After a bipartisan vote in the House and Senate in July, the Senate finally sent the general appropriations bill (H.B. 611) to Gov. Josh Shapiro for his signature on Aug. 3.

There's a lot I would change about H.B. 611, but I was happy to see our chambers work together to keep the wheels of government moving. To call the budget process complete, however, the Senate still must sign off on several fiscal code bills, such as funding for state-related universities like Temple and Penn State.

We've passed a lot of landmark legislation in the House so far this session. Expansion of the Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program, which helps seniors and people with disabilities stay in their homes, was signed into law, and will take effect in January. We also earmarked funding increases for public school districts and workforce development programs for teachers, nurses, and police.

In the second half of this year's session, I

hope to see the Senate approve several other important bills we sent them, including a minimum wage increase and tax credits for child & dependent care.


