



make this event possible!




Our joint Senior Resource

Harrisburg Happenings

LGBTQ+ individuals deserve the same protections in housing, employment, and public accommodations as every other Pennsylvanian. HB 300 passed the House and is now awaiting a vote in the Senate. This legislation will prohibit discrimination in our state based on sex, sexual orientation, or gender identity/expression.



I attended the House Majority Policy Committee hearing which gathered testimony from minimum wage earners and public policy experts as we continue to make the push to increase the minimum wage in Pennsylvania.
