Proof of Identity: Choose 1

- Certificate of Birth (with raised seal)
- Valid Passport

Proof of Social Security: Choose 1

- Social Security Card, or W-2 form, or SSA-1099 form, or non-SSA-1099 form,

Or pay stub with applicant's name and full Social Security number on it.

Proof of PA Residency: Choose 2

- Current PA Driver's License/ID Card
- Current PA Vehicle Registration Card
- Proof of Insurance
- Bank Statement (no more than 90 days old)
- W-2 Form or Pay Stub
- Tax Records
- Lease Agreement or Mortgage Documents

AND Proof of all Legal Name Changes (if applicable)

- Certified Marriage Certificate
- Court Order

REAL ID Cost & Expiration

PennDOT has determined the one-time fee for people who wish to make their license or photo identification REAL ID-compliant is \$30. In addition, you will pay the current renewal fee regardless of whether your license/ID is up for renewal. If your license/ID is not up for renewal, you will receive a full renewal for four years, plus the additional time you had remaining on your previous license/ID.

My amazing Harrisburg Legislative Assistant, Billie Jo Wolff, celebrating Wawa's 60th Anniversary and expansion to Central PA.



I was proud to be a co-sponsor on Rep. Joe Ciresi's legislation prohibiting cable TV, cellular, and other telecommunications companies, utility companies, and Voice over Internet Protocol companies from charging early termination fees because the individual died before the contract expired. Earlier this year, this legislation was signed into law.



In October, I met with Sen. Maria Collett, Rep. Melissa Cerrato, Rep. Ben Sanchez, and members of the Miracle Field of Horsham PA Board to discuss the progress of the fields that are being built in Horsham at Deep Meadow Park. We look forward to seeing this vision become a reality.



One of the several committees I sit on is the Children & Youth Committee, which helps support legislation to ensure the safety and well-being of children across the Commonwealth. This session, we welcomed a new chair, Rep. Jeanne McNeill, and began discussions on an important piece of legislation concerning foster children.

Looking to clean up your record? Join us for an expungement clinic brought to you by the offices of Rep. Nancy Guenst, Sen. Maria Collett, Montgomery County Public Defenders, and Legal Aid of Southeast PA.

APPOINTMENTS REQUIRED

- Only Pennsylvania arrests are eligible
- Only non-conviction charges, including ARD, or summary convictions with no arrests in the past 5 years can be expunged (non-summary convictions cannot be expunged)
- Many misdemeanor convictions may be sealed if 7 years have passed
- Some low-level drug and property-related felony convictions may be sealed if 10 years have passed
- Must have no current criminal charges
- Must not be serving probation time
- Please bring copies of records (Optional)
