
DEAR NEIGHBOR,



APPOINTMENTS REQUIRED

- Only Montgomery County arrests are eligible
- Only non-conviction charges, including ARD, or summary convictions with no arrests in the past 5 years can be expunged (non summary convictions cannot be expunged)
- Many misdemeanor convictions may be sealed if 7 years have passed
- Some low-level drug and property-related felony convictions may be sealed if 10 years have passed
- Must have no current criminal charges
- Must not be serving probation time
- Please bring copies of records (Optional)

▲ I listened to Governor Shapiro's Budget Address with my fellow Montgomery County Delegates and our Montgomery County Commissioners – Neil Makhija and Jamila Winder.

I made the trek to Clarion

County, PA, to visit a bear den and assist the game wardens with bear tagging. By tagging bears, game wardens can track where each bear originates, how far they travel, and determine their age if they are captured or killed.



▲ I continue to advocate for Full Practice Authority for Nurse Practitioners (NPs) in the Commonwealth. My legislation, HB 739, would grant Full Practice Authority to NPs, helping to increase access to quality healthcare for all Pennsylvanians. No matter where you live—rural, suburban, or urban—quality healthcare should be readily available to everyone.

In April, I attended a news conference to commemorate the 50th anniversary of Gov. Milton J. Shapp's executive order protecting state employees from discrimination based on sexual orientation. This was the first such protection in the nation. It was an honor to join my fellow lawmakers in recognizing this landmark milestone.



IN THE COMMUNITY



► In March, we held our annual Expungement Clinic at the Upper Moreland Free Public Library. Alongside Sen. Maria Collett, Legal Aid of Southeastern PA, and the Montgomery County Public Defenders, we assisted 25 eligible individuals with expunging their records.



In July, I visited The Wall That Heals - a 3/4 touring replica of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial. It was such a moving exhibit that continues to keep the memories of our Vietnam veterans alive.



► Hatboro lucked out with a beautiful, sunny Saturday in May to hold its annual Hatboro Community Day.



► I attended a SEPTA funding rally with my fellow lawmakers, Sen. Collett and Rep. Briggs.



► Another exciting Shred and E-Waste Recycling event at the Upper Moreland High School!



► We had a well-received joint Senior Resource Fair with Reps. Melissa Cerrato and Ben Sanchez. The event had amazing turnout and provided seniors with helpful information from various organizations.

► The Mission Kids Child Advocacy Center Groundbreaking in Plymouth Meeting was monumental. The new facility will better enable Mission Kids to help victims of child abuse achieve justice and healing.



► I joined several lawmakers at the Cradles to Crayons "Legislator's Backpack-a-Thon" in Philadelphia. It is critical to set our children up for success when beginning a new school year.



► I was honored to attend the Grand Re-Opening of the Mattie N. Dixon Food Cupboard, which now offers a Full Choice Food Pantry and clothing boutique.



► Our College Prep Night event provided information to help parents and students prepare for their higher education.
