WHEREAS, Pennsylvania growers produce many of the finest food products available worldwide; and

WHEREAS, Today, the growth of Pennsylvania grapes occurs thanks to the tireless efforts of generations of Pennsylvanians who played instrumental roles in the founding of this nation's great wine industry; and

WHEREAS, The nation's first commercial grapevine nursery operated in Montgomery County in southeastern Pennsylvania; and WHEREAS, With more than 300 wineries in this Commonwealth, Pennsylvania ranks seventh in the nation for the number of wineries and fourth for the amount of wine produced; and

WHEREAS, Our wineries, grapes and grape juice provide an annual 1.5-billion-dollar economic impact to this Commonwealth; and

## C. Analysis of the Bill

The resolution designates September as Hunger Action Month, which is an annual campaign to raise awareness of hunger in the United States and to take action to combat poverty, inequity, and injustice to end hunger for good.

In Pennsylvania, more than 1.5 million individuals experience food insecurity and one in every six children do not know where their next meal will come from. To combat food insecurity, the Commonwealth is working with Feeding Pennsylvania and Hunger-Free Pennsylvania to educate people about the role and importance of food banks in addressing hunger and raise awareness about the need to devote more resources and attention to hunger issues. The resolution highlights the need for public and private entities to work together in every corner of Pennsylvania to take action to end hunger.

- 14 uncertain access to adequate food, is associated with numerous
- 15 adverse social and health outcomes and is a critical public
- 16 health issue; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The fight against hunger requires engaging a wide
- 2 range of public and private entities, including policymakers,
- 3 business leaders, food banks, community organizations, farmers,
- 4 producers and concerned residents; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth is committed to taking action to
- 6 combat hunger in every corner of our State and to provide
- 7 additional resources to those in need; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth is working with Feeding
- 9 Pennsylvania and Hunger-Free Pennsylvania to educate people
- 10 about the role and importance of food banks in addressing hunger
- 11 and raise awareness about the need to devote more resources and
- 12 attention to hunger issues; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Feeding Pennsylvania, Hunger-Free Pennsylvania and
- 14 antihunger organizations across this Commonwealth distributed
- 15 more than 164 million pounds of food last year to Pennsylvanians
- 16 experiencing food insecurity; and

## C. Analysis of the Bill

HR323 recognizes the month of October 2025 as "National Animal Safety and Protection Month" in Pennsylvania to raise awareness on how to keep animals safe and protected.

Animal safety and protection efforts in the United States began in Massachusetts, where the General Court included a law in the Body of Liberties of 1641 that prohibited animal cruelty and the exact origins of the national observance are unclear but it is widely believed to have been established by an organization focused on promoting the safe coexistence of humans and animals.

People are encouraged to celebrate the holiday by microchipping their pets to help prevent them from getting lost, volunteering at animal shelters to support animals in need and visiting zoos to further educate themselves about animal care and conservation

"National Animal Safety and Protection Month" is important because it promotes animal safety by educating the public on proper care and precautions, helps to reduce animal abuse by raising awareness about what animal abuse is and how to report it and supports animal shelters through increased donations from animal lovers during the month
