LIGHTNING PLAN BILLS (part 1)

- PRESS: 35% Clean Energy by 2035
 - Pennsylvania Reliable Energy Sustainability Standard
 - Rep. Danielle Friel Otten & Sen. Steve Santarsiero
- PACER: Make polluters pay
 - Pennsylvania Climate Emissions Reduction Act
 - Rep. Aerion Abney & Sen. Carolyn Comitta
- Community Energy (like community solar)
 - Rep. Peter Schweyer & Sen. Judy Schwank

LIGHTNING PLAN BILLS (part 2)

- Improve Act 129: improve energy efficiency and lower costs
 - Rep. Kyle Donahue & Sen. Lisa Boscola
- RESET: Get clean energy projects online faster
 - Reliable Energy Siting and Electric Transition legislation
 - Rep. Mandy Steele & Sen. John Kane
- EDGE: tax breaks for energy projects
 - Pennsylvania Economic Development for a Growing Economy
 - Rep. John Inglis & Sen. Nick Pisciotano

MAKE YOUR VOICE HEARD

- Ask legislators to support the lightning plan/ prioritize climate action this session:
 - Many of your legislators are probably supportive- thank them
 - Ask members of the PA delegation in Chester County who are not on board yet (mostly house and senate Rs) to support the bills
 - If you know anyone in other districts (especially Senate Leadership) ask them to ask their officials to support the plan, too
 - Reach out to the Governor's office to thank him for leading on this and encourage him to prioritize clean energy and energy efficiency in budget

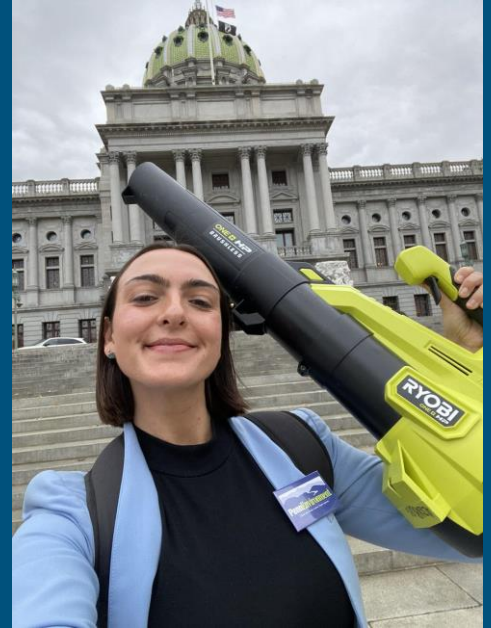
What Else Can You Do?

● Promote/Defend the IRA

- Take advantage of IRA incentives for clean energy and energy efficiency to go solar, switch to a heat pump or induction stove, get an EV and more!
