


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"The Grid"

An interconnected network of power stations, substations, transmission lines, and distribution lines that deliver electricity


PJM: Brief History

- **1927** Three electric utilities formed the Pennsylvania-New Jersey Interconnection
- **1956** Two Maryland utilities join, renaming the pool to "PJM"
- **1965 2013**: System expansion. Eastern KY Power Coop latest utility to join.
- **2001** PJM designated an RTO by FERC



PJM Today

- Independent, nonprofit, Regional Transmission Organization (RTO), headquartered in Valley Forge, PA
- Governed by its membership
- Regulated by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC)
- Largest RTO in the country service territory covers all of PA, plus all or parts of 12 other states + DC. 65 million people.



Energy Auctions



Two Important Design Features

• Interconnection queue

• Line of requests from new power generating facilities to connect to the grid and supply power

• Capacity auctions

• Intended to ensure there is enough electricity to meet demand on the hottest and coldest days of the year. Power plants are paid for their commitment to be available.

Capacity Price "Collar" Proposal

- July 2024 clearing price = \$269.92 / MW-day (2025-26 delivery year)
- Proposed for July and December 2025 auctions (2026-27 and 2027-28):
 - Cap **\$325 / MW-day**
 - Floor \$175 / MW-day
