Click on the link above for the list of scheduled events. <u>To register, click</u> <u>here</u> and select the preferred date and a time. Register for only one (1) time slot and print the ticket. If unable to print the ticket, write the date of the event and time on a piece of paper and have it displayed on the dashboard of your vehicle for the staff to see. Attendees are required to remain in their vehicle at all times and any personal items should be removed from your trunk. **Materials should be boxed for event staff to unload from the trunk of a car, cargo area of an SUV or the bed of a truck.**

NO <u>TV's or Electronics</u> and NO <u>Latex Paint</u> is accepted at the Household Hazardous Waste events. Businesses and contractors will be turned away.




Join us for a parent book talk on May 8, 2025, from 6-8 PM at the Educational Services Center (401 E Hancock Street, Lansdale).
