[To register, click here](#) and select the preferred date and time. Register for only one (1) time slot and print the ticket. If unable to print the ticket, write the date of the event and time on a piece of paper and have it displayed on the dashboard of your vehicle for the staff to see. Attendees are required to remain in their vehicle at all times and any personal items should be removed from your trunk. **Materials should be boxed for event staff to unload from the trunk of a car, cargo area of an SUV or the bed of a truck.**

NO TV's or Electronics and **NO Latex Paint** is accepted at the Household Hazardous Waste events. **Businesses and contractors will be turned away.**

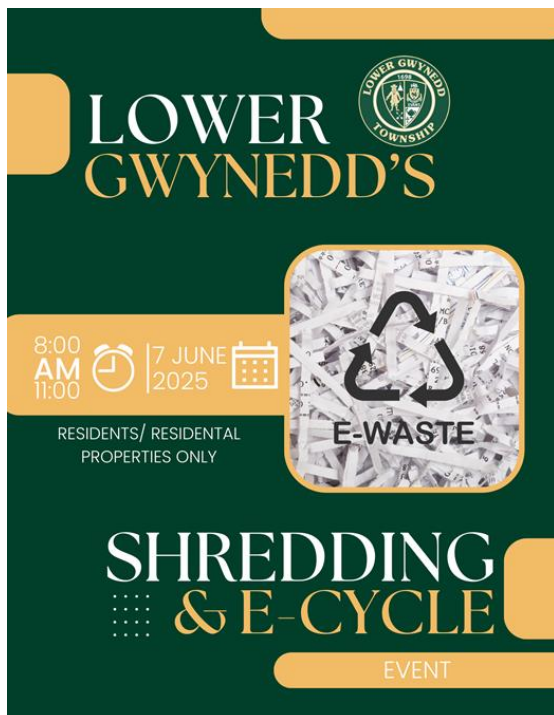

Shredding & E-Cycle Event

Lower Gwynedd will hold a residential e-cycle and shredding event on Saturday, June 7th from 8am-11am (earlier if full capacity is reached, unlikely but possible). We will be accepting PAPER and ELECTRONICS (anything with a plug or battery) at no cost to you. The event is held in the parking lot of the municipal building located at 1130 N. Bethlehem Pike. Please do not enter the parking lot or park in the parking lot prior to the start time of 8am. We need to keep the parking lot open so that the vendors can set up. We will not start early so you will not have access to the vendors prior to 8am. Once the event begins a police officer and staff member will guide you through the lot, you will stay in your car. Items to be recycled or shredded must be placed in the trunk, pick-up truck bed, or a small trailer. Employees will remove these items from your vehicle when you arrive. This event is for residents only, please have your license

with you for verification. Items will only be collected during the event time. Items cannot be delivered before or after the event!! Excessive amounts of paper and/or electronics may be turned away at the Township's discretion.

Movie Nights in the Park Are Back!

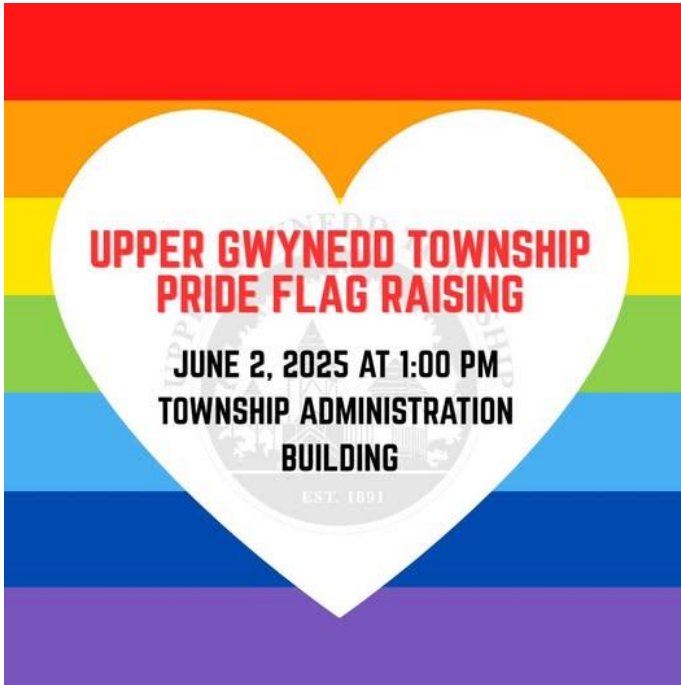
Bring your blankets, low chairs, family, and friends for a fun night under the stars at the DeBarth Amphitheater in Parkside Place Complex!

Upper Gwynedd Township to Raise Pride Flag on June 2nd


