"BLUE ENVELOPE"

DRIVER: Keep your hands on the steering wheel unless otherwise directed.
The officer may shine a flashlight in your car.
When asked for your vehicle/driver documents, hand the officer this envelope.

OFFICER: Driver may show signs of anxiety due to bright lights and noises.
Driver may have difficulty communicating and may not maintain eye contact.
Please speak clearly. Driver's responses may be slow.
Consider contacting the person(s) listed on the form in this envelope.
Clearly tell the driver when the stop is over that they can leave.

The Abington Township Police Department is a part of the "Blue Envelope Program." If you are interested, you can pick one up at the station located at 1166 Old York Road, Abington, PA. The purpose of the Blue Envelope Program is to help vehicle drivers who have conditions such as Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), communication challenges, dementia, anxiety or other conditions that might impair their ability to communicate easily during a traffic stop, car accident or other on-the-road interactions with police officers. The program also raises awareness among police regarding this population of drivers and the kind of driver reactions they may observe during a traffic stop.

TIPS FOR MANAGING SOLICITORS



Tips for Managing Solicitors

- Place a "No Soliciting" sign on your door or somewhere that is visible.
- Register on the "No Solicitation" list that can be found on our website, www.abingtonpd.org.
- Do not confront the solicitors.
- Immediately call 911 to have an officer dispatched to the area if you have a "No Soliciting" sign and/or you are on the "No Soliciting" list and the solicitors still come to your door.

Solicitors should have their soliciting permit on them at all times



Reminder: Non-profit solicitors do not need a soliciting permit

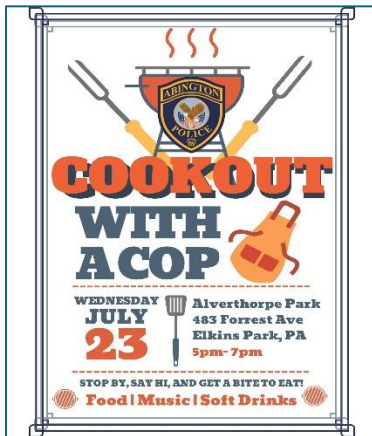
Immediately call 911 to have an officer dispatched to the area if you have a no soliciting sign and/or on the list and they still come to your door

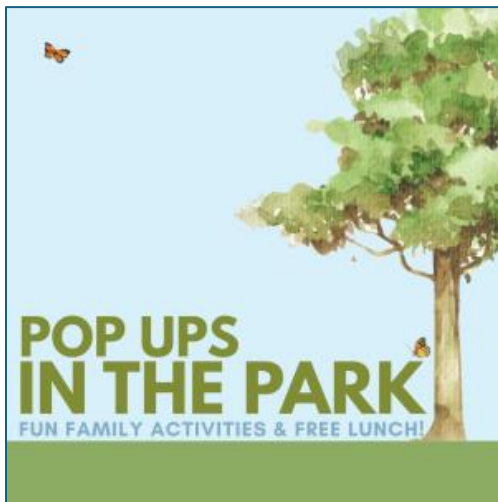

UPPER DUBLIN SUMMER CONCERT SERIES

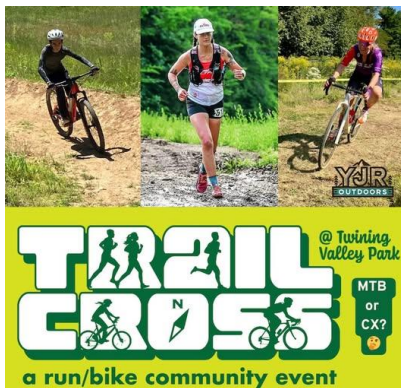


Check out the 2025 Sunday evening concert series lineup!
