Campfire Safety Tips from the Abington Township Fire Department

Heading outdoors this summer? Whether you're in the backyard or out on the trail, campfire safety is key to keeping everyone safe and preventing wildfires.

Before you strike that match, remember these safety tips:

- Choose your spot wisely Use designated fire pits when available. Keep your campfire at least 20 feet from any buildings or fence lines.
- ✓ Keep it small and manageable A smaller fire is safer and easier to control.
- ✓Never leave it unattended Always have an adult present and keep a bucket of water or hose nearby.
- ✓ Extinguish completely Douse with water, stir the ashes, and douse again until cold to the touch. ✓ Follow local fire regulations Check for any burn bans or restrictions before starting a fire. Let's all do our part to enjoy the outdoors safely and responsibly. Feel free to check our ordinance to make sure you are in compliance with Abington Township codes!

-As the weather reaches high temperatures in the afternoons, it's important to remember that if you're feeling the heat, so are your pets.


Keep them cool and hydrated

Come for a visit from Pete the Cat, an inflatable obstacle course, crafts, sprinkler, and more!


