MOSQUITO SPRAYING IN ABINGTON



Alternate Date: Wednesday, August 27, 8-11p.m.

The Montgomery County Department of Health & Human Services (HHS) Office of Public Health (OPH) will be spraying to control the adult mosquito population on Wednesday, August 20, 2025, from approximately 8 PM to 11 PM, weather permitting. The alternate date will be Wednesday, August 27. All areas within the highlighted sections of the below map will be subject to the spray. Border roads include Old Welsh Road, Easton Road, Rockwell Road, Rothley Avenue, Hamilton Avenue, and Woodland Road. Residents within the spray area should consider remaining indoors, closing windows, and turning off ventilation systems that draw in outside air for the duration of the spray plus 30 minutes afterward.

ARDSLEY WILDLIFE SANCTUARY CLOSED



Ardsley Wildlife Sanctuary is currently closed for construction. Works hours are 7 AM - 5 PM, Monday through Friday. This is currently Phase 2 of the planned construction, which is focusing on extending the ADA trail and reforestation from the terminus of the Phase 1 trail to the large pond to the north. The township expects completion of the project by the fall.

ABINGTON POLICE DEPARTMENT (APD) COUCH TO 5K WITH A COP




Started August 18 (weekly, every Monday, until 11/8) at 7p.m.

UPPER DUBLIN SHOOTING STARS CAMP




Monday, August 25 to Thursday, August 28




WELCOME NEW BOROUGH MANAGER, JACK LIPSETT
