MONTGOMERY COUNTY HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE EVENTS

Registration is now available for the 2025 Montco Household Hazardous Waste events. Click on the link above for the list of scheduled events. To register, click here and select the preferred date and time. Register for only one (1) time slot and print the ticket. If unable to print the ticket, write the date of the event and time on a piece of paper and have it displayed on the dashboard of your vehicle for the staff to see. Attendees MUST remain in their vehicle at all times and any personal items should be removed from your trunk.

NO <u>TV's or Electronics</u> and NO <u>Latex Paint</u> is accepted at the Household Hazardous Waste events. Businesses and contractors will be turned away.



Vape Buy-Back Program

Parents and guardians of teens, the Montgomery County Department of Health and Human Services is launching its 3rd cohort this Fall! Here's how the program works:

- Parents can complete an interest form, which is available here.
- Families will receive an email with more information along with a DocuSign permission slip.
- A pre-paid envelope is mailed directly to the family for returning the vape safely and confidentially.
- Teens participate in ten (10) one-hour virtual sessions. Once completed they earn a \$100 reward.

You might not know it, but Fall is an excellent time to plant trees! The Environmental Advisory Council is having its annual native tree giveaway Friday, October 24th from 4 PM to 7 PM at the Pavilion at Parkside Place. No reservations will be accepted – this will be on a first come, first serve basis for Upper Gwynedd Township residents only. There is a limit of 3 trees or shrubs per household. A variety of native trees and shrubs, mostly in #3 containers, will be available for residents to take home, including the following:

Alleghany serviceberry (Amelanchier laevis)
Umbrella Magnolia (Magnolia tripetala)
American Plum (Prunus americana)
Chinkapin Oak (Quercus muehlenbergii)
Pawpaw (Asimina triloba)
Redbud (Cercis canadensis)
Sugar maple (Acer saccharum)
White Fringe Tree (Chionanthus virginicus)
Sweet Birch (Betula lenta)
Pagoda Dogwood (Cornus alternifolia)

Shrubs

Red osier dogwood (Cornus sericea)
American Hazelnut (Corylus americana)
Sweet Pepperbush (Clethra alnifolia)
Witchhazel (Hamamelis virginiana)
Smooth Hydrangea (Hydrangea arborescens)
Red Chokeberry (Photinia pyrifolia)
Mapleleaf Viburnum (Viburnum acerifolium)



Whitpain EAC 2025 Recycling Event Battery & Media & Wrist Watches

Drop off Dates: March 8, June 7, and October 11, 2025

Collection of Used Batteries, Disc Media, and Wrist Watches are being collected and recycled for Whitpain Township residents three times per year. Details of all acceptable items:

Household Battery Details:

Batteries that are accepted for recycling include:

Alkaline, Zinc-Carbon, Nickel, Lithium, Mercury, Silver Oxide, Coin/Button Cells, Lead Acid, including rechargeable and single use batteries

Large volumes of batteries cannot be handled by this program as it is designed for small volumes of batteries used by Whitpain Township residents. We **do not** accept car batteries or any industrial batteries.

Alkaline Batteries:

- No need to tape alkaline batteries
- · Corroded alkaline batteries must be separated into clear plastic baggies

Lithium Battery Taping Instructions:

All lithium batteries and batteries over 9V (small tool batteries) MUST BE TAPED. Terminals must be covered with clear scotch tape (do not use packing, electrical, or duct tape) to prevent accidental short-circuiting during shipping, which could cause a fire. Most hearing aid, watch, and button batteries are lithium and must be taped.



Easy taping method: Line up batteries, apply a strip of tape to them, flip them over, and put another piece of tape on top.

Acceptable Media/Tapes/Cases/Film items

- Disk Media: CDs, CD-Rs, CD-RWs, DVDs, DVD-Rs, Blu-ray, LaserDisc, 3.5" and 5.25" floppy disks, zip and jaz disks, and cases.
- Tapes: VHS-all types, audio cassette tapes, 8mm, Hi8, mini DV, DAT, DLT, LTO, Beta, BetaCam, BetaMax U matic/3/4" tape, DVCam, Digibeta, 8-Track, reel-to-reel audio, and cases.
- Cases: All types of plastic CD and DVD cases, All types of plastic video and audio tape cases.
- Film: Black and White film-related items only. Please do not include color film or any type of photograph.
 - Black & White Photographic film negatives, instant film and sheets, sheet film, Advanced Photo System, slides, Disc film, 110, 126, 127, 120/220
 - Black &White or undeveloped only: Motion picture film, film reels, Super 8, 8mm, 9.5mm, 16mm, 35mm, 70mm.
 - o Black and white only: microfilm, microfiche, lithographic film.
 - o Medical x-ray, industrial x-ray.
