New socks are one of the most needed items at homeless shelters because they wear out fast and are rarely donated.



HOW YOU CAN HELP:

- Drop off non-perishable food items (**no glass**) and/or
- Drop off pair(s) of socks all styles and sizes (infant to adult)



MOST IMMEDIATE FOOD NEEDS:

- Canned vegetables (green beans, all varieties of veggies)
- Beans, soup (bean, tomato & seafood), beef stew
- Sides (Rice a Roni, Knorr, Chef Boyardee products, etc.)
- Tomato sauce (for pasta)
- Ketchup, mustard, mayo
- Tomato products (diced, crushed, whole, stewed, etc.)
- Granola Bars
- Rice, pasta, Asian noodles (Ramen) & cereal (regular & sweetened)
- Peanut butter
- Canned meats (SPAM, tuna)

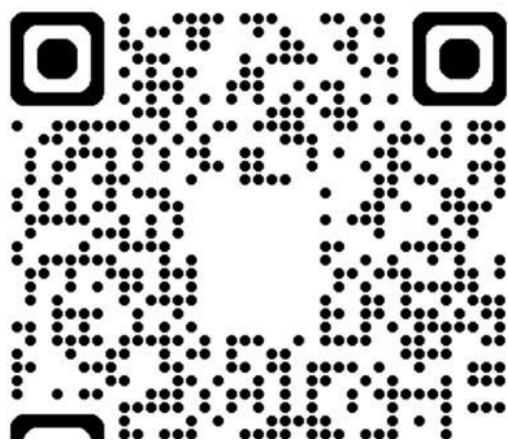
It also covers the political debates, cost issues, and the split on the school board that came with building it.

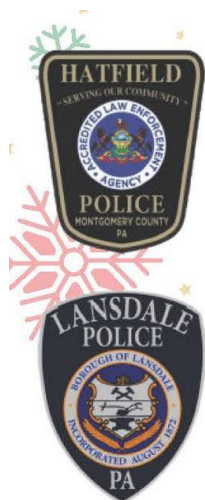
