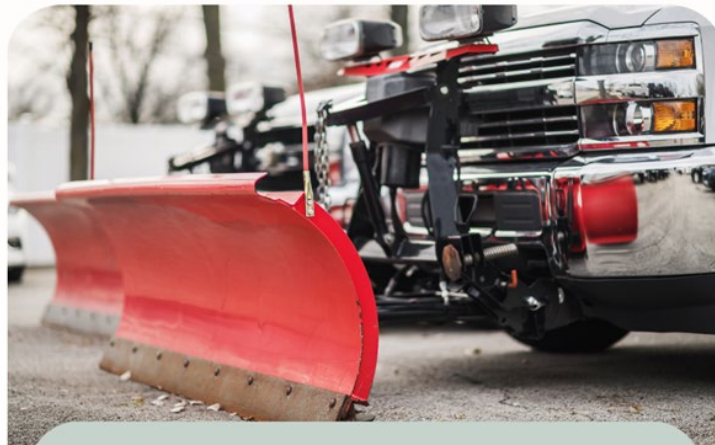
Who Should Attend?
