Senior Update 2015

BUDGET 2015-2016

Gov. Tom Wolf's proposed budget is a bold plan that would greatly benefit seniors. This proposal would virtually eliminate school property taxes for residents of the Allentown School District, offering much-needed relief to the thousands of seniors living in our city.

Budget hearings wrapped up March 26. I hope that all members of the House and Senate, Democrat and Republican, will keep an open mind in the weeks and months to come so we can make a positive change for Allentown and all of Pennsylvania.

RECYCLING EXEMPTION FOR SENIORS

Did you know that you may qualify for a \$35 rebate from the Allentown Municipal Waste and Recycling Fee? If you are 65 or older, live in the City of Allentown, own and occupy the home you live in, and have a total household income of no more than \$15,000, you can file a request for the rebate from the City Department of Finance. 911 FUND

As a member of the Veterans Affairs and Emergency Preparedness Committee, I am fighting hard to make sure Allentown's 911 system can remain an independent system. Some in Harrisburg are trying to force us to join a regional system. This could increase the time it takes an ambulance, police officer or fire truck to arrive at an emergency, risking our public safety. Working with leaders from the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency and local leaders, I am fighting to protect our right to have

an Allentown person answer a 911 call from an Allentown resident. Our public safety is too important for people in Harrisburg to play politics with.

PROPERTY TAX/RENT REBATE PROGRAM

My staff can help senior citizens and others who qualify for the state's Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program.

Applications are now available to apply for this popular program.

Pennsylvanians 65 or older, widows and widowers 50 or older, and people with permanent disabilities 18 or older may qualify for benefits under the program. The annual income limit for homeowners is \$35,000 and \$15,000 for renters. When calculating your annual income, you only need to count 50 percent of your Social Security income, and Social Security COLAS are excluded. The maximum standard rebate is \$650.

FREE LANTA BUS PASSES

Folks 65 and older can ride free on LANta's fixed-route during regular operating hours. You must present either a Commonwealth I.D. or a Medicare Card. Contact LANta at 610-776-7433 to receive an application for a Commonwealth I.D. card.

Getting to my district office is now even easier. LANta's 104 line has both a northbound and southbound stop for the office. When you stop by, you can also pick up a bus schedule.



SAVE MONEY ON YOUR MEDICARE COVERAGE

Do you know everything you need to know about your Medicare coverage? Did you know there are programs that could help you save money on your monthly premiums? My office is here to help.

A volunteer benefits counselor is available the third Tuesday of every month from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. The meeting will take about an hour. To make an appointment, give my office a call at 610-791-6270.

WORKING FOR YOU IN HARRISBURG

I am a member of the Aging and Older Adult Services Committee, which deals with improving the lives of Pennsylvania's older population. That includes getting older Pennsylvanians dealing with mental health issues the care they need and deserve. The committee recently voted on a bill that would create a council that would make recommendations to state agencies on how to handle long-term care. My amendment to study behavioral health issues in seniors was adopted and added to the bill.
