I look forward to another productive year working with local officials, first responders, school officials and organizations on plans to better our district's communities.

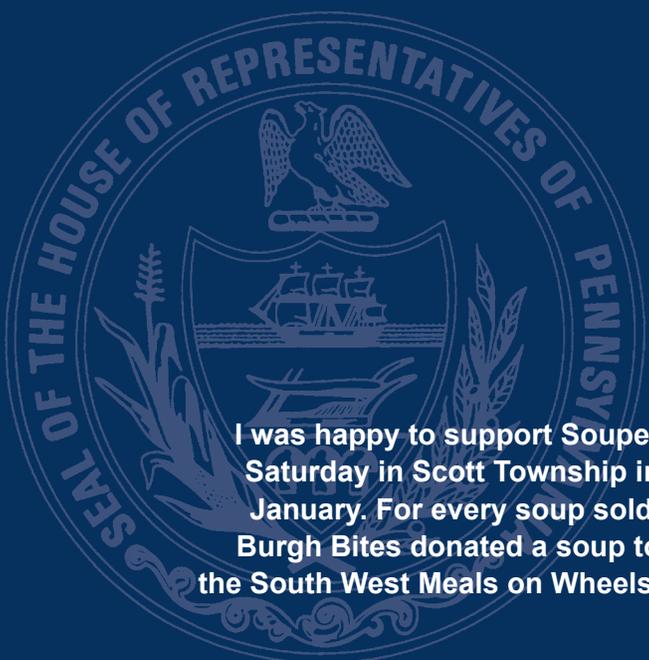
My staff and I welcome residents to my Coraopolis and Carnegie offices to help with a wide range of state-related issues. This newsletter outlines some of the many ways we can help.

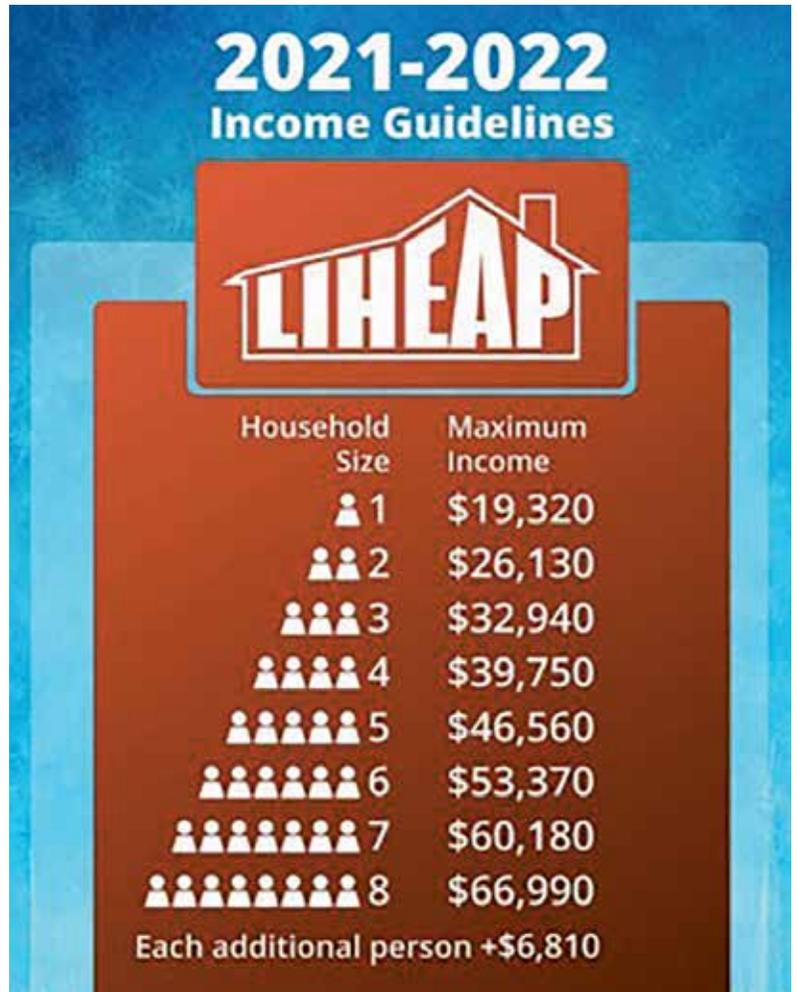
I was happy to support Souper Saturday in Scott Township in January. For every soup sold, Burgh Bites donated a soup to the South West Meals on Wheels.

Real ID enforcement postponed until 2023

REAL ID enforcement has been postponed until May 3, 2023, in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Starting that date, Pennsylvanians will need a REAL ID-compliant driver's license, photo ID card, or another form of federally acceptable identification (such as a valid passport or military ID) to board a domestic commercial flight or enter a federal building or military installation that requires ID.

REAL ID is optional for Pennsylvanians. Additional details are available at www.penndot.gov/REALID.



Apply now for the 2021 Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program

Older Pennsylvanians and those with disabilities can now apply for rebates on property taxes or rent paid in 2021. Eligible applicants for the Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program are encouraged to visit my.path.pa.gov to electronically submit their applications. If you are unable to apply online or need assistance, please contact my office at 412-264-4260.

Affordable Rx for seniors

Older Pennsylvanians living on fixed incomes should never have to choose between affording medicine and affording food, rent or heat. Pennsylvania's prescription assistance programs for older adults, PACE and PACENET, offer low-cost prescription medication to qualified residents age 65 or older.

In the fall, I voted to help 100,000 more of our wisest friends and neighbors qualify for PACENET by raising the income limits to \$33,500 for a single person and to \$41,500 for a married couple.

Financial help for drinking water and wastewater service

Are you or someone you know at risk of losing water service at home? Help is available for Pennsylvanians who need help with water bills or who may lose water service.

The Low Income Household Water Assistance Program is now open. Relief is available to families who have past-due water bills, had their service terminated, or received a notice indicating that their service will be terminated in the next 60 days.

Need help heating your home?

LIHEAP, the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program, helps eligible families pay their heating bills through a cash grant. Households in immediate danger of being without heat may also qualify for crisis grants.
