Dear Neighbor,

That familiar chill is returning to the air, and after a very long summer, the state budget remains in the balance.

We've been very productive in the Pennsylvania House of Representatives this session. If you're signed up for my weekly email updates, you know we've passed some bills that make me proud, including a budget bill that is with the Senate.

These are just a handful of our recent accomplishments:

- Passed a bill that would make it harder for private equity firms to purchase hospitals, giving the Attorney General much more oversight on such transactions;
- Voted to reign in cyber charter schools to make them more accountable to taxpayers and lessen their financial burden on public schools;
- Passed legislation to update the tax code so that large, multi-state corporations can't dodge Pennsylvania taxes anymore.

We also voted to ban companies from charging you hidden "junk fees," restore dental coverage for Medicaid recipients, and deliver the funding to keep SEPTA rolling here in Delaware County and beyond.

All of these bills are now with the state Senate for their consideration and votes before they can become law.


Knocking on doors and catching up with our neighbors around the community is one of the ways I keep tabs on the issues that matter most to you – and what I can do in Harrisburg to support you.


