# GOVERNOR SHAPIRO SIGNS MY NINTH BILL INTO LAW!



In Harrisburg, I've worked to keep our community's priorities front and center - fairness, opportunity, strong public schools, safe neighborhoods, and a government that shows up.

## I recently helped pass legislation establishing:

- ✓ The new Working Pennsylvanians Tax Credit, putting money into the pockets of nearly one million PA workers.

- ✓ Strengthen election security and accountability.

# BRINGING STATE INVESTMENT TO OUR NEIGHBORHOODS



Since taking office, I've helped secure **more than \$60 million** in state funding for our community.



## I've also recently delivered:

- ✓ **\$947,000** to close a key gap in the **Schuylkill River Trail**
- ✓ **\$500,000** to **Saul High School** for a solar energy project
- ✓ **\$65,000** to **Saul High School** for renovations and upgraded security
- ✓ **\$80,000** for a new gym floor at **Cook-Wissahickon School**
- ✓ **\$400,000** for **Chestnut Hill Hospital** to expand women's health services
- ✓ **\$400,000** for the renovation of the historic stairs on **Gay Street**
- ✓ **\$247,781** to restore the railroad tie retaining wall along the **Manayunk Towpath**
- ✓ **\$86,450** to support **Small Things** to help feed local hungry families.

These are vital, local investments in our neighborhood that make our community more beautiful, stronger, and more livable.

**That's how the government should work.**
