## Legislative Updates:

As you may have heard, the Pennsylvania House of Representatives and Senate passed a bipartisan budget that will invest tax dollars into our communities—without raising taxes or touching the Rainy Day Fund. Below are some more details:

- Pennsylvania's long-retired teachers, police, and firefighters are finally getting an overdue pension increase through the 2026-27 state budget. Eligible retirees, including those in PSERS, SERS, and municipal police/fire systems, will see COLAs ranging from 15% to 24.5%.
- We are putting money back in the pockets of nearly one million working families in Pennsylvania through the Working Pennsylvanians Tax Credit. By building on the federal Earned Income Tax Credit, the program helps working families keep more of what they earn and better manage the rising cost of everyday expenses.
- This budget increases state funding for public schools by nearly \$670 million. That includes:
  - ➔ a \$58 million increase in Basic Education Funding
  - ➔ a \$46.75 million increase in Special Education Funding
  - ➔ a \$565.1 million increase in Ready to Learn Funding
  - ➔ and Career and Technical Education will be receiving \$154 million, a \$10 million increase.

**Additionally, I will be introducing a bill that would create a refundable statewide child tax credit for families with children under six years old.** This credit would help alleviate some of the crushing costs on families, lift young children out of poverty, and tackle the affordability crisis in a real way. Stay tuned—I look forward to sharing additional details soon.

In addition to the work my colleagues and I are doing in Harrisburg, my office offers a variety of free resources that may benefit you.

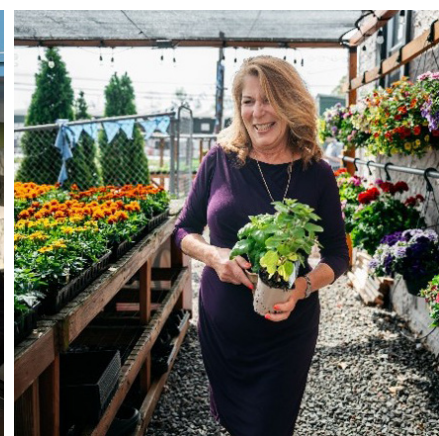

**Funding for our Community**

I will continue fighting to bring money back to Bucks County and fund projects that directly benefit Bristol Township and Bristol Borough.

**This year alone, we have brought in over \$2 million in grant funds for the following projects:**

- **\$176,711** for Office of the State Fire Commissioner Fire/EMS Grants
- **\$1,502,187** in Commonwealth Financing Authority grants for economic development projects
- **\$300,000** for the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources Community Conservation Partnership Program for park rehabilitation and development
- **\$51,534** in PennDOT Automated Red Light Enforcement grants for safety improvements to the signalized intersection of Bristol Pike and Green Lane
