State Rep. Anita Astorino Kulik and the Allegheny County Sheriff's Office are sponsoring a PROJECT D.U.M.P. drug-disposal event beginning at 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. Saturday, May 12, at Fairhaven Park, Kennedy Township.

Residents can safely and anonymously dispose of unneeded, unwanted or expired prescription drugs often stored in home medicine cabinets at the free event.

Safely disposing of medications keeps potentially dangerous drugs away from those susceptible to drug abuse and dependence. Safe disposal through PROJECT D.U.M.P. – Disposal of Unused Medications Properly – also is environmentally friendly, keeping drugs out of the waste stream and from polluting our water.

Rep. Kulik and her staff also will be distributing information on illegal drugs and substance abuse at the May 12 event.
