- **ConnectCard**: The Port Authority of Allegheny County is issuing a photo ID ConnectCard that will provide senior citizens with free transit. The ConnectCard takes the place of the commonly used Medicare card and existing Port Authority Bus Pass that seniors have been using for free bus or light rail rides. The Medicare card is no longer accepted for free transit as of Jan. 1, 2020. Due to this, I want to invite all seniors – 65 and up – to this event so that my highly trained staff can help you obtain a ConnectCard by assisting you with the necessary application and photo requirements. You must provide an acceptable photo ID to begin the process. From there it should only take about four weeks for the Port Authority to process the information, produce the card and ship it to my office. When we come back to
- <u>Drug D.U.M.P.</u>: If you have any unused or unwanted medications, you can properly dispose of them at this event. These medications will be collected by an Allegheny County Deputy Sheriff and will be properly disposed.
