Protect your identity by having personal documents shredded.

Safety measures in place: no need to leave your car - just drive up and my staff and I will remove your papers and take to the shred truck.

Destroy all those old tax returns and important papers you have been holding onto – papers with personal information including:

- Documents containing Social Security, credit card and bank account numbers.
- Credit card applications.
- Canceled or unused checks.

- Insurance and income tax records.
- Bank and credit card statements.
- Pension information.

Paper must be loose - no binder clips or paper clips.

Documents cannot be in binders.

Documents will be shredded on-site by a reputable and bonded company.
