## CASE MANAGEMENT

Each participant is assigned an Employment Consultant to provide them with resources, assist them with aligning their goals and alleviate any barriers to employment or training. All goals are developed on an individual basis while supporting each client's needs and self-growth.



## JOB SEARCH ASSISTANCE

We have Job Developers that will help the participant with career assessment, resume preparation and finding employment. They have a large employer base to pull from while supplying job leads and coordinating interviews within high priority occupations.

## TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES

We offer onsite or virtual short-term training. We also partner with other organizations that provide free certificate training, including Manufacturing, Microsoft Office, and Healthcare certifications. For those who have not obtained their GED, we provide partnerships to support you in gaining your GED. We also offer referrals to partners for long-term training goals, including an associate or bachelor's degree.



## FAMILY ADVOCATE/ SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL SUPPORT

We have Family Advocates virtually and onsite that support participants and their family members as they transition to and from the EARN program. Such support includes but is not limited to personal challenges and family crises. If more intensive services are needed, they will connect participants to outside professionals and do a soft hand-off. We support you, your family, and your goals!

## CHILDCARE & TRANSPORTATION

Childcare and transportation assistance is provided to program participants who are enrolled in a training program, obtaining employment or pursuing a secondary degree.
