HOUSE BILL

PA ADULT-USE CANNABIS: WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

*** LEGALIZATION OVERVIEW**

B 20 would legalize adult-use (recreational) cannabis in Pennsylvania for individuals 21 and older. A new, independent authority—the Keystone Cannabis Authority (KCA)—would regulate all cannabis activity, including medical and adult use.

KEY DATES & INFORMATION

- Law Takes Effect: 90 days after passage
- Temporary Rules: In place for up to 2 years
- **Medical Cannabis**
 - Still available and expanding
 - Dissolves Medical Marijuana Advisory Board and grants KCA oversight authority
 - Transfers Medical Marijuana Funds to KCA - 80% to Community Opportunity Fund, 20% to Cannabis Regulation Fund

WHAT CAN YOU LEGALLY **POSSESS?**

- Mirrors Ohio law
- Up to 2.5 ounces of cannabis flower
- Up to 1,000 mg of THC in edibles
- Up to 15 grams of cannabis concentrates

SOCIAL & ECONOMIC EQUITY

- Majority of new licenses would go to social equity applicants, remainder would be available for small businesses
- Any surrendered or rescinded licenses would be made available to social equity, disadvantaged business, and small business applicants
- Creates the Community Opportunity Fund which would:
 - Invest in communities disproportionately harmed by the War on Drugs
 - Support social equity applicants by funding grants, loans, training, business incubators, and other resources to help social equity cannabis businesses get to doors open



TAXES & WHERE YOUR MONEY GOES

13% effective tax rate (8% sales + 5% excise) to support:

- Community Opportunity Fund (25%)
- Pennsylvania General Fund (20%)
- Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency (15%)
 - 10% to local law enforcement for cannabis regulation enforcement
 - 5% to support public defenders' offices
- Municipalities with cannabis businesses (10%)
- Drug prevention & treatment (10%)
- Cannabis Regulation Fund for program administration (10%)
- Agriculture investments (5%)
- Medical Marijuana patient assistance (5%)







CONSUMER & PUBLIC SAFETY

- Only licensed dispensaries may sell, with civil penalties of up to \$10,000 per offense for unlicensed sales
- Requires rigorous product testing, clear labeling, and childsafe packaging
- Regulates Delta 8, Delta 9, synthetic hemp, and THC products currently being sold in unlicensed retail locations
- Prohibits ads targeting kids or near schools

PROTECTION OF RIGHTS

- Firearm rights protected for legal users
- Employers may still enforce drug-free workplace rules

CRIMINAL JUSTICE REFORM

- Automatic expungement of past cannabis-related convictions
- Release and resentencing for incarcerated individuals with expunged convictions
- Restores licenses and driving privileges
- Medical cannabis users protected from zero tolerance THC-based DUI charges



MATERIAL PROPERTY OF THE PROP

Allowed only for medical patients
up to 5 plants per patient

HOME DELIVERY

 Licensed dispensaries may deliver cannabis to your home

DON'T DRIVE HIGH

 Impaired driving under the influence of cannabis remains unlawful but mere presence of cannabis metabolites alone is not sufficient to prove impairment
