## Senior Citizen Real Estate Tax Freeze

The City of Philadelphia and Department of Revenue will "freeze" your real estate tax if you meet certain age and income requirements. Under the Real Estate Tax Freeze, the amount of property tax you pay each year will not increase, even if your property assessment or the tax rate changes. If your tax liability decreases due to a lower property assessment or a tax rate decrease, the amount of real estate tax you owe will also be lowered to the new amount. The deadline to apply is Sept. 13, 2022.

For purposes of this program, an eligible senior is someone who meets any of the following descriptions:

- A person 65 years or older;
- A person who lives in the same household with a spouse who is 65 years or older; or
- A person 50 or older who is a widow or widower of someone who reached the age of 65 before passing away.

Eligible applicant(s) must have a total income of:

- \$33,500 or less for a single person; or
- \$41,500 or less for a married couple.

Eligible senior citizens living in cooperative buildings may enroll in the program. If you are an eligible senior, you must complete a special "COOP APPLICATION" and follow a process that involves sharing your enrollment status with your building's property management.

# Property Tax/Rent Rebate Bonus Payment

One-time bonus payments will soon be on the way for older Pennsylvanians or people with disabilities who have been approved for a rebate on taxes or rent paid in 2021.

The bonus rebate – funded in the 2022-23 state budget with \$140 million in American Rescue Plan Act funds – will be equal to 70% of the applicant's regular rebate.

If you have already applied and received your rebate, you do not need to do anything. The state Department of Revenue will send the additional funds in the coming weeks in the same manner as the initial rebate, either by check or direct deposit.

If you have not applied, don't wait! The deadline for the Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program is December 31, 2022. Please reach out to my office to find out if you qualify and for assistance with filling out an application. You can also apply online by going to www.mypath.pa.gov.
