It provides four-year scholarships to two high school seniors and is used toward the cost of tuition and fees for a four-year program at a college, university, or career school in Pennsylvania.

- Legal Residency in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- Attendance at a PA college, university, or career school as a full-time student
- Academic achievement (minimum 3.0 cumulative high school GPA)

- Financial need
