I joined some of my colleagues and criminal justice advocates to discuss the importance of compassionate release for incarcerated individuals. We must ensure that incarcerated people who are suffering from chronic medical

conditions or some sort of extraordinary event are able to be released so they can get the urgent help they need. In the future, I plan to introduce legislation on this issue to grant geriatric individuals parole.



It was an honor to meet Civil Rights icon Rev. Jesse Jackson! Rev. Jackson has fought for the rights of Black Americans and all marginalized groups for more than half a century. He is a hero to so many, including myself, as he has sacrificed so much of himself for the betterment of our nation.





Gov. Josh Shapiro delivered his budget address for 2025-26 in the Pennsylvania House Chamber. His proposed budget includes investments in crucial areas such as mass transit, public education, our workforce, child and dependent care, and much more. Additionally, his proposed budget would legalize adult-use, recreational cannabis and invest in programs that benefit our seniors. Over the coming months, my colleagues and I will negotiate the budget and look to pass a finalized version. I will do my part to ensure we include the important funding the governor proposed so that we can move Pennsylvania forward!



## STATE PROGRAMS



During the cold winter weather, it's important that you're able to stay warm in your home. You can apply for assistance with your heating bills through the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP). My office is here to help you apply or see if you qualify so don't hesitate to contact us if you're unsure or need assistance. You have until April 4 to apply.



You can now apply for a rebate on the property taxes or rent you paid in 2024 through Pennsylvania's Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program. This program is open to seniors 65 or older, widows or widowers 50 or older, and people with disabilities 18 or older. My office is here to help you apply or see if you qualify, so don't hesitate to contact us if you're unsure or need assistance. You have until June 30 to apply.
