PROPERTY TAX/RENT REBATE APPLICATIONS AVAILABLE

More than 425,000 Pennsylvanians have begun receiving a total of \$258 million in rebates on property taxes or rent paid in 2024.

The Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program benefits income-eligible seniors 65 or older, widows or widowers 50 or older, and residents with a disability 18 or older. The program now offers rebates up to \$1,000 and nearly 150,000 first-time applicants have already benefited.

Applications are still available and the deadline to apply for a rebate on rent or property taxes paid in 2024 is Dec. 31, 2025.

The Pennsylvania Treasury has almost \$4.5 billion in unclaimed funds and properties on its books, and some of it may belong to you!

Approximately 10% of Pennsylvanians have unclaimed property, and my office is here to assist in checking your status, and expediting the process so you receive your money faster.


