A BILL OF MINE IS NOW LAW!

I was the first freshman member this session to have a bill signed into law! My bill authorizes the transfer of state-owned land in Harrisburg to the Susquehanna Regional Transportation Authority (SRTA), which operates as rabbittransit/CAT. This land conveyance is essential for allowing SRTA to construct a modern transit facility to replace its outdated headquarters, a project vital for improving reliability, maintenance, and future expansion capacity of the regional transit system. SRTA's services span 12 counties and are dependent upon by an estimated 9,200 riders daily, with nearly 60% of them having no other means of transportation. This legislative success ensures the long-term stability and efficiency of public transit for millions of annual passenger trips across the region.


